

Hybrid Performance of



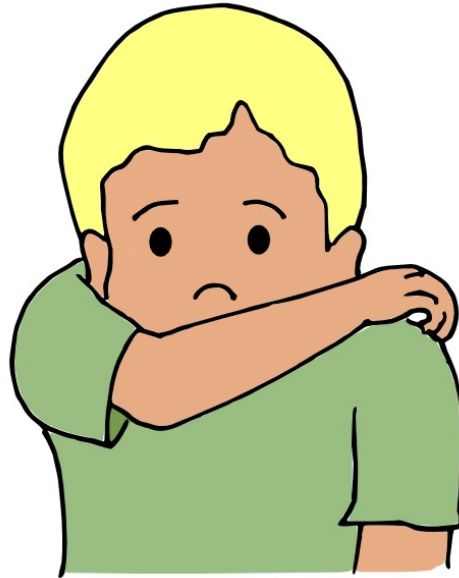

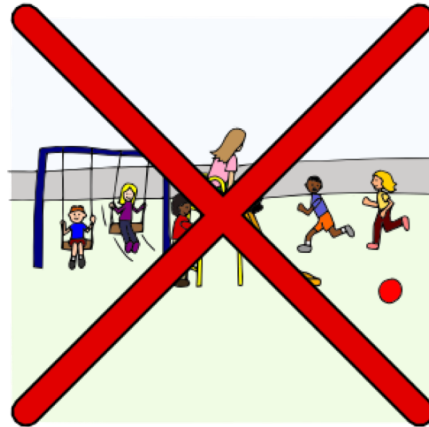
I should try not to shake hands with people even though it's a nice greeting. Instead, I can wave, smile, or give an air five to someone to say hello.
